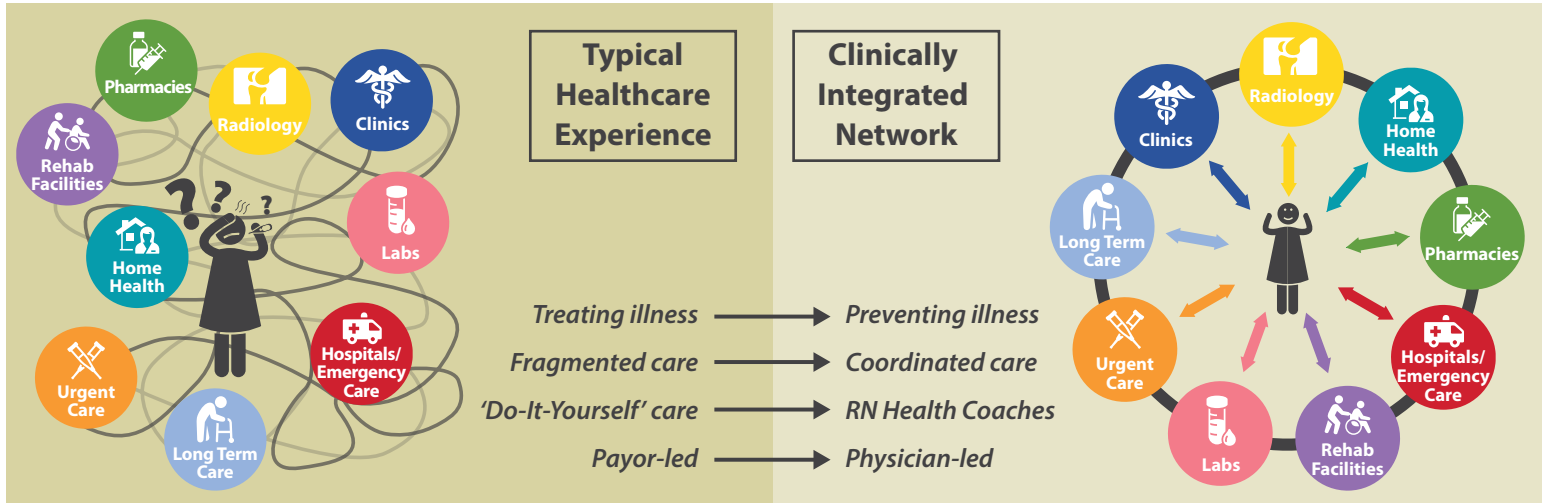


About Arkansas Health Network

Arkansas Health Network (AHN) is a physician-led clinically integrated network wholly-owned by CHI St. Vincent. In 2013, AHN was established with the mission of building on the strengths of participating providers to achieve the Triple Aim of improved patient health, increased efficiency, and better quality of care. AHN has proven itself to be the most successful and innovative CIN in the state, serving over 2,600 participating providers and 117,000 patients statewide.

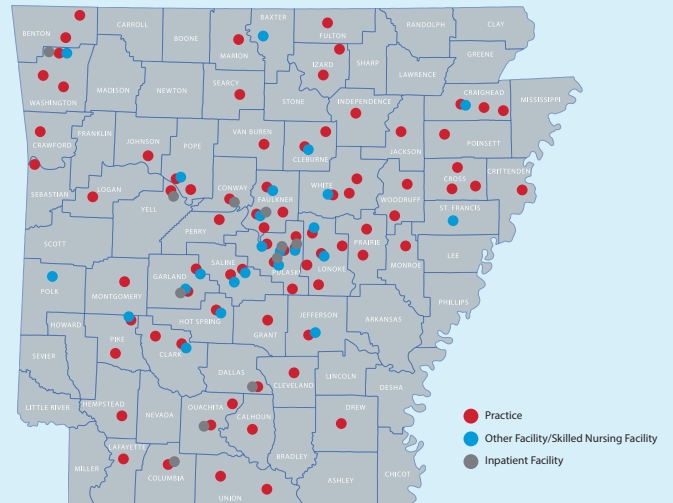

Direct-to-Employer Services



Employers are facing year-over-year cost increases to their health plan due to increased premiums and declining health of their members. To address these needs, AHN formed an innovative partnership with Arkansas Children's Care Network (ACCN), a statewide pediatric CIN, and Next Health (NH), a CIN based in Northwest Arkansas. Together AHN, ACCN, and NH offer an industry unique model of care to deliver value to self-funded employer health plans. The model consists of a high-value statewide provider network of over 2,800 providers, multidisciplinary care management, and proactive analytics.

All three CINs bring prior success and experience in other governmental and commercial contracts which translate to improved cost, quality, and experience for the whole family. As of 2021, the CINs are jointly working together to manage over 16,000 employee health plan lives with continued growth in 2022.

Recent Achievements

Direct-to-Employer Contracts:

In 2018-2020, AHN was awarded \$1M in total performance-based payments for the CHI St. Vincent Health Plan for cost and quality success. AHN also achieved 14% savings for the Anthony Timberlands, Inc. Health Plan in 2019 compared to prior year.

Medicare Shared Savings Program:

AHN has saved Medicare over \$31M (\$18M earned shared savings) through repeat successes in 2014, 2017-2019. AHN has earned the most shared savings of any ACO fully based in Arkansas.

QualChoice Advantage

AHN received \$997K for achieving cost targets for the 2017 QualChoice Advantage contract.

Distributions to Provider Networks

AHN has distributed \$4.3M to its participating provider network based on contract successes.
