1. To create an account
 1. You will need a Medicare number to create an account
 - i. This can be found on your Medicare card or you can find it by logging into your Social Security account

Medicare Card

Check your red, white, and blue Medicare card. Enter your Medicare Number as it appears on your Medicare card, with or without dashes. Check carefully, since letters can look similar to numbers. (The letters B, I, L, O, S and Z are not used in Medicare Numbers.)

1. Terms that maybe useful

- i. Medicare Advantage Plan: an additional charge to your Medicare coverage that will give you a fixed network of physicians to choose from
 1. Advantages: Fixed network of providers
 2. Disadvantages: Additional costs, limits providers (especially tricky when traveling)
- ii. Medigap Policy: an additional cost in which private insurance companies will help fill some of the coverage gaps of Medicare
- iii. [Medicare Part D](#): this is an additional cost that will help cover your medications under an insurance plan

Done Adding Drugs

1. You will need to put in your prescriptions accurately
 1. It will ask you:
 1. What drug you take
 2. What strength
 3. How many you get
 4. How often you get it filled
 2. This should all be located on your pill bottle
 1. You can always call your pharmacist if something is not clear
2. Add all of your medications to your list and then click done adding drugs
