Clinic-Based Initiative to Drive MSSP Success

As we've highlighted throughout the year, **Annual Wellness Visit** (AWV) compliance and improving **risk recapture** through appropriate Hierarchical Condition Category (HCC) coding have been key initiatives for optimizing our performance in the Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP).

Starting in September, our RN Health Coaches partnered with a select group of practices to advance these efforts through **tailored interventions**, including AWV scheduling support, onsite RN-led AWV completion, and the creation of patient-specific HCC face sheets for providers.

Since then, our team has created over **900** HCC face sheets, scheduled nearly **300** AWV appointments, and performed more than **100** AWVs in clinics. These efforts have positioned us for a record year in AWV completion and improved risk score accuracy, which can lead to increased shared savings. Thank you to everyone who worked on this project!

Pharmacy Corner

Pharmacy Initiative Improves Patient Medication Adherence

In 2024, our Network Pharmacist and RN Health Coaches made over **900 calls** to pharmacies to facilitate the conversion of maintenance medications for hypertension, hyperlipidemia, and diabetes to a 90-day supply for patients within our network. Their efforts resulted in a **60% conversion rate**, helping patients save on out-of-pocket costs and reduce the risk of missed doses.

This initiative supports AHN's commitment to enhancing care and supporting better health outcomes. Looking ahead, we plan to implement similar interventions to further improve medication adherence and patient well-being.

CHI St. Vincent Service Recognition Awards

Three of our exceptional RN Health Coaches were recently recognized at **CHI St. Vincent's Service Recognition Awards Banquet** for their outstanding years of service. MSSP Quality Payment Program Reporting

As a reminder, AHN is participating in the MSSP Enhanced Track. To remain in the program and be eligible for certain incentives, the following reporting requirements must be met annually:

- Enhanced Track MSSP ACO -- Advanced Alternative Payment Model (AAPM)
- Shielded from MIPS downside risk -- **1.88%** APM Incentive Payment and an increased physician fee schedule update based on the QP conversion factor
- Streamlined reporting requirements compared to MIPS

2024 Reporting Requirements

Quality	Practices do not need to report via MIPS. Requirements met through annual ACO Quality reporting.
Improvement Activities	Practices do not need to report via MIPS. ACO participants receive 100% credit.
Cost	No reporting needed under MIPs.
Promoting Interoperability	ACO groups must report to CMS individually through QPP on an annual basis.
